3	<p>French – Moi (All about me) Introducing simple French phrases and greetings looking at cultural differences.</p> <p>French - Jeux et chansons (Games and songs) Learning to count to 20 and talking about favourite games.</p>	<p>French – On fait la fete (Celebrations) Talking about achievements in games and activities, learning the names of the months and birthday greetings.</p> <p>French – Portraits (Portraits) Learning about the main parts of the body and describing colours.</p>	<p>French – Les quatre amis (The four friends) Learning about animals and describing their colour and movement. Listening and responding to a story.</p> <p>French – Ca pousse! (Growing things) Learning about the names of vegetables, what we like and don't like.</p>
4	<p>French – On y va! (All aboard) Learning the days of the week, and some phrases relating to transport and weather.</p> <p>French – L'argent de poche (Pocket money) The purpose of this unit is to offer children the opportunity to manipulate numbers, introduce them to euros, and allow them to express likes and dislikes.</p>	<p>French – Racontez-moi une histoire! (Tell me a story) Teaching awareness spellings in the context of a fairy tale. The unit also teaches multiples of ten, up to 100, and extend their use of instructions.</p> <p>French - Our Sporting Lives Learning about sports and healthy and unhealthy eating habits.</p>	<p>French – Le carnaval des animaux (The carnival of animals) Learning the names of some animals and learning to tell the time.</p> <p>French – Quel temps fait-il? (What's the weather like?) Learning more phrases to describe the weather and talk about the temperature. Learning to describe the clothes they need to wear in particular weather conditions.</p>
5	<p>French – Les Planetes (The planets) Children will learn the names of the planets and recognise the written words in French; order the planets; describe the planets and write some sentences about them.</p> <p>French – En route pour l'école (On the way to school) Children will learn to say the alphabet; follow, ask and give directions and describe their route to school.</p>	<p>French – Je suis le musicien (I am the music man) Children will learn to discuss their musical preferences and to say which instruments they play; learn an adaptation of the song 'I Am the Music Man'; explore rhythm and create a rap for a performance.</p> <p>French – Le retour du printemps (The return of spring) Children will describe the weather in different seasons; say which month and season their birthday is in; respond to a poem and describe the seasons.</p>	<p>French – Bonne appetite, bonne sante! (Healthy eating) Children will name, label and describe some food items and recognise some feminine and masculine nouns.</p> <p>French – Scene de plage (Beach scene) Children will use both new and familiar language to describe the painting 'Scène de plage' by Degas; use their knowledge to write and perform their own poetry inspired by the painting.</p>
