#### **Forest School**

We have a wonderful nature area which is used by all children. During their time at The Meadow children will be able to participate in forest school activities such as denbuilding, making knots and camp fires.

#### **Gardening and Cooking**

We offer all our children the chance to grow, cook, and enjoy school-grown produce. We encourage children to make healthy lifestyle choices.

#### **Trips**

With the backing of parents, the school engages in diverse educational excursions to locations like theatres, museums, and other points of interest. A residential trips is organised providing a more immersive learning experience. Children are able to learn how to do archery, rock climbing, high ropes, trapeze, circus skills and puzzle solving.






